Grand Canyon National Park ● Bryce Canyon ● Escalante National Monument ●
Capitol Reef National Park

7 days/ 6 nights

This trip can be experienced with a full-time guide and vehicle or self-drive. Refer to the pricing tab.

Day 1: Arrive into St. George, Utah.

Fully guided: You will be met by your guide and transferred to your luxury tented accommodations which will be your home for the next 2 nights.

Self-Drive: pick up your rental car (paid directly) and follow the directions to your luxury tented accommodations where you will be received by the camp staff.

Day 2: Grand Canyon National Park - North Rim

You will have a full day with your Guide to explore the North Rim of the Grand Canyon. There are several short hikes that offer incredible views of the canyon including Cape Royal & Angels Window. Cape Royal is a short hike (approximately 1/2 mile) offering a viewpoint at Angels Window which is a natural arch in the canyon before ending at Cape Royal. All hikes are catered to your interest, stamina levels and level of adventure.

Day 3: Bryce Canyon National Park; Escalante National Monument

Today your expert Guide will take you to Bryce Canyon National Park for a half-day privately guided hike. Spend time in the two largest amphitheaters in Bryce Canyon, hiking into the maze of hoodoos that make Bryce a unique experience. Trail selection will be based on how everyone feels, and your interest in strenuous vs. easy hiking. You'll hike 2 to 6 miles and then take in some of the great viewpoints along the 17-mile scenic drive further south on the Paunsaugunt Plateau including Bryce Point, Sunrise Point, and Sunset Point. Later, transfer to your luxury camp near Escalante National Park. The spectacular high desert landscape filled with junipers and deeply carving canyons at your private camp will become your home away from home during your stay in the Southwest. The location of this camp offers one-of-a-kind access to explore the local canyons, rivers, and waterfalls that make Escalante world-renowned.

Day 4: Escalante National Monument

The Escalante region is known for exploring via several different excellent hiking options. This will give you a great sense of the incredible canyons, hoodoos and creeks that dominate the landscape. You can explore Devils Garden, a unique desert playground of hoodoos and arches. Carved by wind and water over the centuries, the formations stand out in a stark landscape of sand and heat. Right off the main access road the hiking is easy and flat. There is no specific trail to follow - just a pathway winding around the various formations which you can enjoy at a leisurely pace. Further down Hole-in-the-Rock Road, you will arrive at Spooky Gulch and Peek-a-boo Slot Canyons. This roundtrip hike offers an incredible hiking experience in the

remote slot canyon areas of Escalante. At the end of your tour, your guide will transfer you back to camp to refresh, rejuvenate, and enjoy dinner under the stars.

Escalante Luxury Camp (B,L,D)

Day 5: Lower Calf Creek Falls & UTV Tour

Calf Creek Falls is one of the most well-known and unique features in Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument. The trail follows Calf Creek to the 126-foot high falls. The hike is 6 miles round trip and takes an average hiker approximately 3 to 4 hours in duration at a nice, leisurely pace. After lunch, depart on half-day excursion on UTV's which takes you into the backcountry surrounding Capitol Reef National Park. You will travel through the varied landscape surrounding the park boundaries, high mountain plateaus and vast canyons offer the most quality experience which you should come to expect in a southern Utah all-terrain vehicle tour. Later, transfer to your luxury accommodations.

Day 6: Capitol Reef National Park & Roping Experience

Explore Capitol Reef National Park by foot. Your private guide will discuss the various options with you to ensure a memorable experience and ensure some scenic routes that are easy to navigate. In the evening, meet your wranglers where you will then get a private roping lesson in which you will

learn different lasso techniques while watching the cowboys fine tune their skills. Many of their technique have been passed down over many generations and still used today.
