Yellowstone National Park - Grand Teton National Park

Day 1: Arrive into Yellowstone Airport

Fully guided: Immediately embark on a guided behind-the-scenes Grizzly & Wolf Discovery Center Tour.

Self-Drive: Self-Drive: pick up your rental car (paid directly) and follow the directions to the Grizzly & Wolf Discovery Center. After the visit, make your way to your luxury camp where you will be met by your camp staff.

The Center offers visitors to Yellowstone a chance to uniquely experience the world of grizzly bears and gray wolves.

Later transfer to your luxury accommodations. The Yellowstone Luxury Camp was created for those who want to experience the wild outdoors in comfort. Set up exclusively for you, this private campsite enables you to enjoy the best that nature has to offer in a secluded, tranquil area with upscale accommodations.

Day 2: Explore Yellowstone & Yellowstone Falls

This morning, your guide will take you to see the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone and Yellowstone Falls. The specifics of the geology of the canyon are not well understood, except that it is an erosional feature rather than the result of glaciation. After the caldera eruption of about 600,000 years ago, the area was covered by a series of lava flows. The area was also faulted by the doming action of the caldera before the eruption. The site of the present canyon, as well as any previous canyons, was probably the result of this faulting, which allowed erosion to proceed at an accelerated rate.

At 308 feet, the Lower Falls is the tallest waterfall in the park. In terms of height alone, it's more than twice the size of Niagara Falls. The amount of water flowing over the falls varies greatly depending on the season. Although the Upper Falls of the Grand Canyon of Yellowstone is significantly smaller than their lower counterpart, they're just as breathtaking. Standing on the platform at the Brink of the Upper Falls, this 109-foot cascade of surging water will look every bit as

powerful as it is. At the end of your excursion, your will be transferred you back to your luxury camp for the night.

Day 3: Explore Lamar Valley & Stargazing

Early morning visit the Lamar Valley. The early wakeup call will be worth it as a sunrise exploration of Lamar Valley is the ideal location for wildlife viewing! It is considered a mecca for migrating wildlife in the Yellowstone ecosystem. Check into your hotel in the Grand Teton and relax until your departure for an evening star gazing excursion. Your Grand Teton experience will begin with a nearly unlimited view of the night sky where you can enjoy the use of state-of-the-art telescopes and iPads featuring the Sky Safari app as expert astronomers guide you through cosmos. Refreshments including wine, cheese, charcuterie, and desserts will also be served. When you've had your fill of the stars, your guide will return you to your hotel, filled with new memories that are guaranteed to last a lifetime.

Day 4: Whitewater Rafting and Rodeo Experience

Depart for a white water rafting excursion (Class 3 rapids). After every section of whitewater you go through, there is a calm section to follow and take in the scenery. It's quite an easy river to navigate and its fully guided by expert.

Enjoy the Jackson Hole Rodeo has been a part of Jackson Hole's cowboy culture for over a century. Tonight you will be a VIP, going behind the chutes to see how the cowboys and cowgirls prepare for the rodeo. Once the rodeo starts you can proceed to your VIP skybox for up-close viewing of all the action.

Day 5: Archery & Air Guns; Wildlife at Sunset

This morning, enjoy a private Jackson Hole 2-Hour air gun & archery experience. It's a fun family and group activity. As the sun sets, depart for an evening wildlife safari! Your guide will take you to wildlife hotspots in the Tetons, which are often located on low-traffic paths on unmarked dirt roads. Plan on uninterrupted wildlife observations followed by a wealth of information provided by your knowledgeable guide who has a passion for the area. **Caldera House (lunch)**
